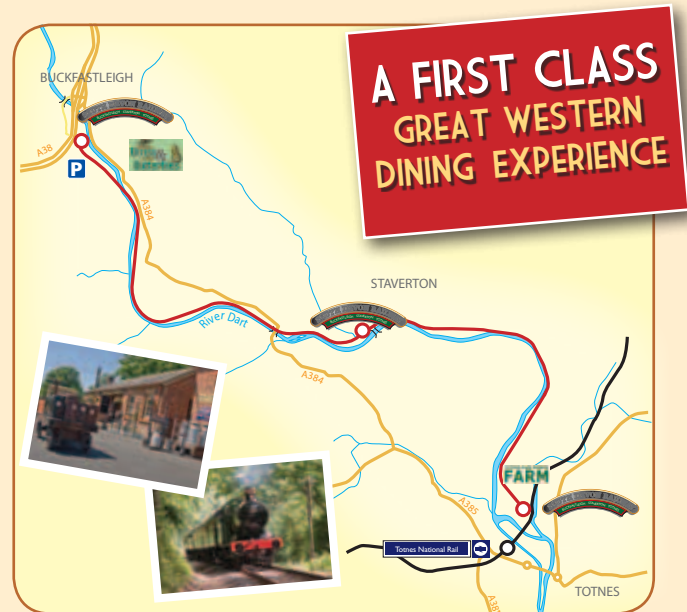

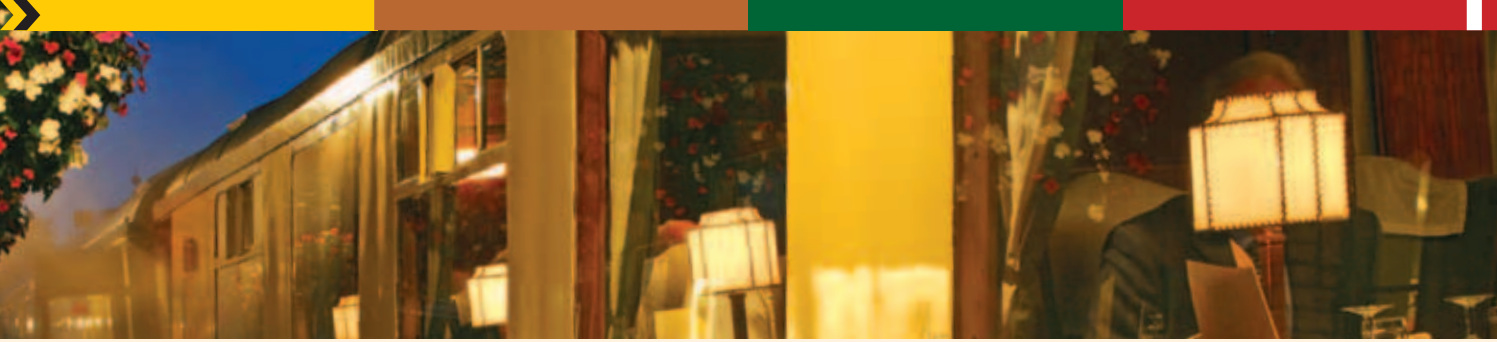

The train comprises historic carriages, including 'King George' and 'Duchess of York', from the GWR's Ocean Liner Express, which ran from London to Plymouth to connect with the Trans-Atlantic steamers, and GWR Special Saloon 9005.

The journey, which lasts around two and a half hours, takes you on a leisurely trip from Buckfastleigh, where you board the train, to Totnes and back.
